#### **MORNING PRAYERS**

Joys/Concerns/Teacher Appreciation Confession & Pardon

Pastor: In the act of confession, we acknowledge how we have missed the mark, and we call upon God to save us from the destruction of sin and turn us back toward life. Let us now confess our sin before God and one another.

We confess that we have not loved you as you command us to love. We have not relied on you as our refuge, choosing instead to seek comfort in busyness and distractions. We have not trusted that only when we put ourselves in your hands can we find peace the peace we crave.

All: Let your face shine upon your servant; save me in your steadfast love.

Pastor: We confess that we have not loved our neighbors as you command us to love. We buy into the myth that it's every person for themselves. We ignore the pain of those around us. We refuse your call to care for the poor and the marginalized.

All: Let your face shine upon your servant; save me in your steadfast love.

Pastor: We confess that we do not answer your call to steward creation. We look upon the earth as something to consume instead of tend. We point fingers at others instead of doing what is ours to do. We choose comfort over responsibility.

All: Let your face shine upon your servant; save me in your steadfast love.

Offer silent prayers of confession.

Pastor: Hear these words: When we call, God inclines an ear to us and comes quickly to help us. God's love is steadfast to rescue us and redeem us. In the name of Jesus Christ, you are forgiven!

All: In the name of Jesus Christ, you are forgiven! Glory to God! Amen.
